A Priority For Action - Stewardship

- We are called to be good stewards of God's gifts.
- We strive to work collaboratively, sharing resources with integrity and accountability, ensuring sustainability.
- Stewardship is defined as the responsible use of time, talent and treasure. It is perceived as important for both the mission of the Church and the well-being of each Christian. It is meant to "affirm and promote participation in the development of vibrant communities."
- Stewardship is identified as a "significant priority" in the development of vibrant faith communities. It would seem important to develop a common understanding of what "a culture of stewardship" would be like for us as a diocese and for our parishes.
- While the objectives set out are based on an understanding and acceptance of this culture, it cannot be assumed that the values underlying them are a given.
- The main tasks set out in the objectives seem to center around defining, assessing, prioritizing, planning and promoting good stewardship.
- Pastoral care, nurturing and sustenance of our people require what is set forth in the Stewardship section of the document.

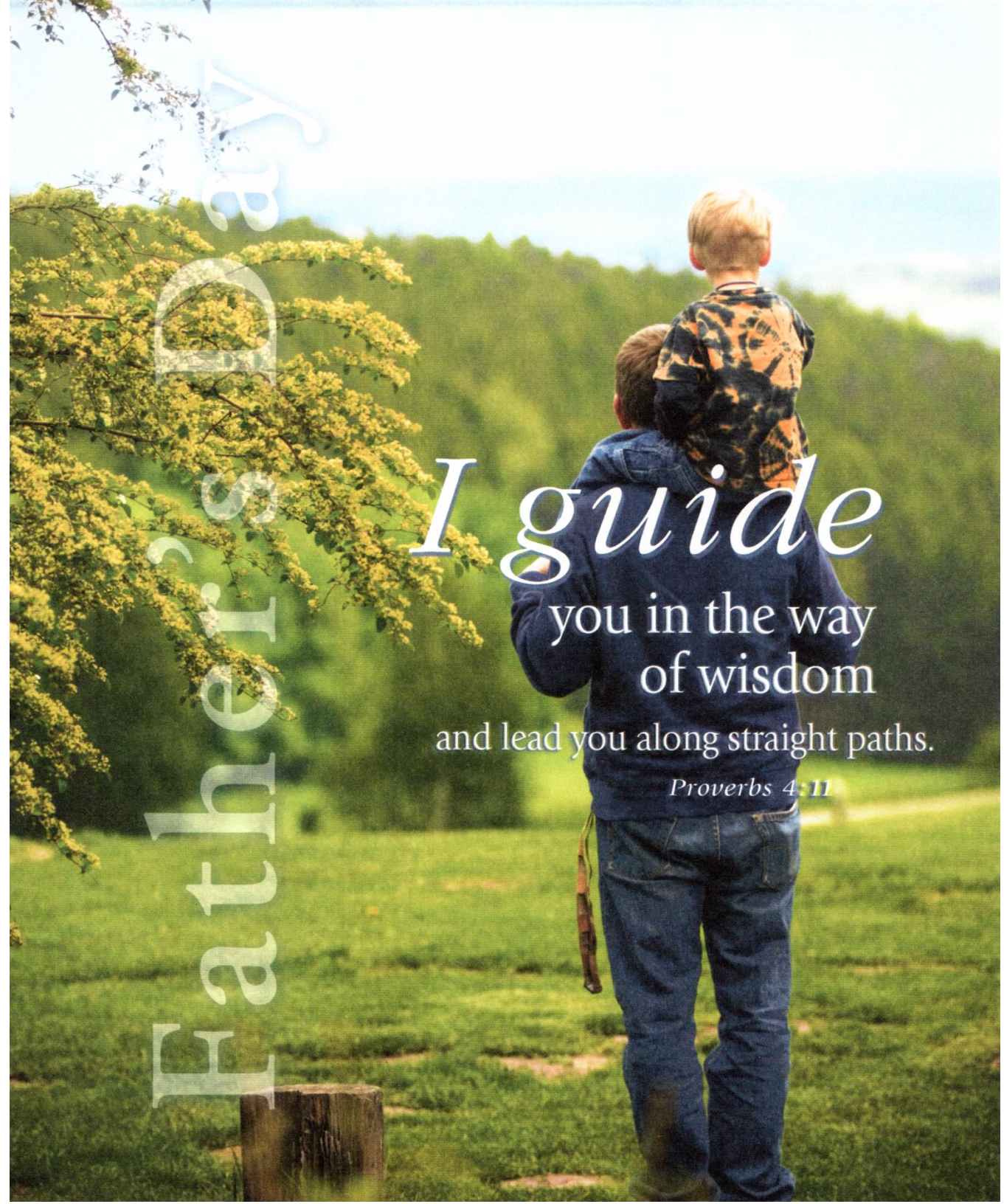
