A Priority For Action - Catechesis And Formation

 - vibrant liturgies in celebrating the Sacraments and mission oriented activities for all ages
 - Diocesan Lay Pastoral Ministry Formation Program
 - on-going formation for priests and deacons
 - programs through the Villa Madonna Retreat House, St. Thomas University and Camp Sheldrake
