The next Saint Joachim's CWL meeting will be held on Monday, March 14th, 1:30pm. Please use the K of C entrance.

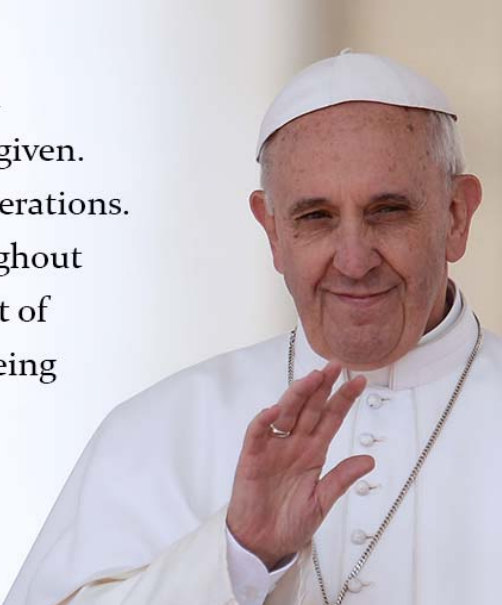
Chrism Mass

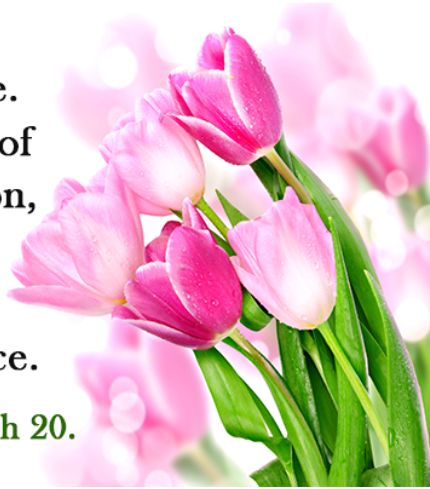


Easter Flowers
