Tea

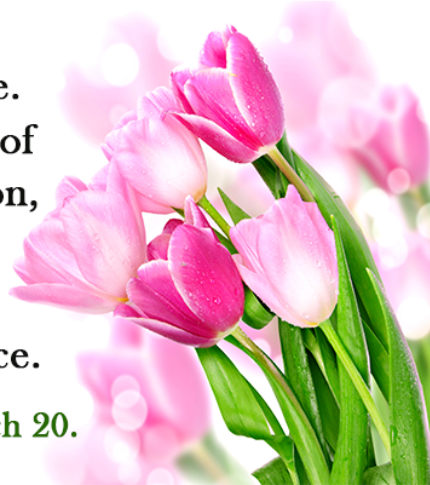
