Dear Sisters and Brothers:

Our annual “**Christ the King Collection**” is rapidly approaching. As usual, it will be taken up on the *Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe*, which occurs this year on Sunday, November 20, 2016.

I wish to redefine the cause for this collection. Initiated in 1987 by Bishop Edward Troy in support of the priests' pensions and the formation of seminarians, from now on this collection will be to support priests who are on leave because of illness. At the moment I am seeking your help to help me care for our priests who in the course of their ministry need to go on sick leave. I am committed to our priests as you are. When they are sick, we need to offer them the best care possible to restore them to health and ministry.

On Sunday, November 20, I ask that the “**Christ the King Collection**” be taken up in every parish and mission church in our diocese to help support our priests who, on sick leave, need special care. Your generosity will be a way of saying “thank you” to these priests and all priests who have responded to God’s call to serve and be there for you. Know that your contribution, large or small, is eligible for an income tax receipt. I am most grateful for your understanding and grateful for your help – as we care for our priests.

The *Solemnity of Christ the King* marks the end of the *Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy*. I trust that you have experienced God’s mercy during this year and are continuing to be instruments of God’s mercy to others.
